**The Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Amendment,
Revocation and Consequential Provision) Regulations 2024**

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1), (2) and (7) and 19 of the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Act 2023 (“the 2023 Act”)(**a**).

The Secretary of State is a relevant national authority for the purpose of section 14(1) and (2) and 19 of the 2023 Act(**b**).

Insofar as Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety(**c**) applies to these Regulations, there has been consultation as required by that Article during the preparation, evaluation and revision of food law in relation to these Regulations.

The requirements of paragraph 6(2) of Schedule 5 to the 2023 Act (relating to the appropriate Parliamentary procedure for these Regulations) have been satisfied.

PART 1

Introductory

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Amendment, Revocation and Consequential Provision) Regulations 2024.

(2) Except as provided for in paragraphs (3) and (4), these Regulations come into force on 6th April 2025.

(3) The following provisions come into force on 23rd June 2026—

- (a) regulation 7 so far as it relates to Chapter 2 of Part 2 of the Schedule;
- (b) Chapter 2 of Part 2 of the Schedule.

(4) The following provisions come into force on 6th April 2030—

- (a) regulation 7 so far as it relates to Chapter 3 of Part 2 of the Schedule;
- (b) Chapter 3 of Part 2 of the Schedule.

Extent and application

2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), these Regulations extend to England and Wales, Northern Ireland and Scotland.

(2) Any revocation of an enactment, and any amendment or revocation of a provision of an enactment, has the same extent and application as the enactment, or the provision of the enactment, revoked or amended.

PART 2

Amendment of assimilated direct legislation

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/11

3.—(1) Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/11 of 6 January 2015 entering a name in the register of protected designations of origin and protected geographical indications (Kranjska klobasa (PGI))(a) is amended as follows.

(2) Omit Article 1.

(3) In Article 2, for the first paragraph substitute—

“The registration of ‘Kranjska klobasa’ as a protected geographical indication does not prevent the terms ‘Krainer’, ‘Käsekrainer’, ‘Schweinskrainer’, ‘Osterkrainer’ and ‘Bauernkrainer’ being used to market a product in Great Britain that does not conform to the product specification for that protected geographical indication.”.

(4) After Article 3 omit the words from “This Regulation” to “States.”.

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/1992

4. For Article 2 of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/1992 of 6 November 2017 entering a name in the register of protected designations of origin and protected geographical indications (‘Slavonski kulen’/‘Slavonski kulin’ (PGI))(b) substitute—

(a) EUR 2015/11.
(b) EUR 2017/1992.

“Article 2

The registration of ‘Slavonski kulen’/‘Slavonski kulin’ as a protected geographical indication does not prevent the terms ‘kulen’ or ‘kulin’ being used either in those forms or in translation to market a product in Great Britain that does not conform to the product specification for that protected geographical indication.”

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/506

5.—(1) Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/506 of 26 March 2018 entering a name in the register of traditional specialities guaranteed (‘Pražská šunka’ (TSG))(a) is amended as follows.

(2) In Article 1—

(a) in the first paragraph—

(i) for “names” substitute “registered TSG names to which this Regulation applies are”;

(ii) omit “are registered as TSG”;

(b) omit the second paragraph.

(3) For Article 3 substitute—

“Article 3

1. The registration of ‘Pražská šunka’ as a traditional speciality guaranteed does not prevent products specified in paragraph 2 from being marketed in Great Britain using that term until existing stocks of those products are exhausted.

2. The specified products are products that:

(a) do not comply with the definition and conditions of use that apply to the use of ‘Pražská šunka’ as a traditional speciality guaranteed,

(b) were imported into, and marketed in, Great Britain using that term before 17th April 2023, and

(c) are on the market in Great Britain on 6th April 2025.”.

(4) After Article 4 omit the words from “This Regulation” to “States.”.

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1718

6.—(1) Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1718 of 14 October 2019 protecting the traditional terms ‘Opolo’, ‘Vrhunsko vino s kontroliranim zemljopisnim podrijetlom (Vrhunsko vino KZP)’, ‘Kvalitetno biser vino’, ‘Mlado vino’, ‘Vrhunsko pjenušavo vino’ and ‘Kvalitetno vino s kontroliranim zemljopisnim podrijetlom (Kvalitetno vino KZP)’ identifying wines produced in Croatia(b) is amended as follows.

(2) In Article 1, in the first paragraph, for the words before point (a) substitute “This Regulation applies to the following traditional terms:”.

(3) For Article 2 substitute—

“Article 2

1. The registration of the protected terms to which this Regulation apply (“the relevant protected terms”) does not prevent the grapevine products specified in paragraph 2 from being marketed in Great Britain using those terms until existing stocks of those products are exhausted.

2. The specified products are grapevine products that:

(a) EUR 2018/506.

(b) EUR 2019/1718.

- (a) were produced in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and
 - (b) in the case of an individual product:
 - (i) the relevant protected term used for the product is traditionally used for that type of product in Bosnia and Herzegovina,
 - (ii) it does not comply with the definition and conditions of use that apply to the relevant protected term,
 - (iii) it was imported into, and marketed within, Great Britain using one of the relevant protected terms before 5th November 2024, and
 - (iv) it is on the market in Great Britain on 6th April 2025.”.
- (4) After Article 3 omit the words from “This Regulation” to “States.”.

PART 3

Revocation of assimilated legislation

Revocation

7.—(1) The legislation listed in column (1) of the Tables in the Schedule is revoked to the extent specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) of the Tables.

(2) In that Schedule—

- (a) the Table in Part 1 lists subordinate legislation;
- (b) the Tables in Part 2 list assimilated direct legislation.

PART 4

Amendment consequential on revocations made by Schedule 1 to the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Act 2023

The Genetically Modified Organisms (Deliberate Release) Regulations 2002

8. In the Genetically Modified Organisms (Deliberate Release) Regulations 2002(a) omit regulations 11(1)(d), 16(2)(j) and 34(3)(i).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend and revoke specified secondary assimilated law (within the meaning of section 11(2) of the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Act 2023 (c. 28) ("the 2023 Act") which relate to agriculture, the environment and food.

Part 2 (regulations 3 to 6) amends assimilated direct legislation relating to—

- (a) Kranjska klobasa, a protected geographical indication (regulation 3);
- (b) Slavonski kulen/Slavonski kulin, a protected geographical indication (regulation 4);
- (c) Pražská šunka, a traditional speciality guaranteed (regulation 5);
- (d) Opolo, Vrhunsko vino s kontroliranim zemljopisnim podrijetlom (Vrhunsko vino KZP), Kvalitetno biser vino, Mlado vino, Vrhunsko pjenušavo vino and Kvalitetno vino s kontroliranim zemljopisnim podrijetlom (Kvalitetno vino KZP), protected traditional terms (regulation 6).

The amendments include amendments that replace provisions in the assimilated direct legislation that achieve the same objectives as the provisions they replace but that make adjustments to take account of the application of those provisions to Great Britain.

Regulation 7 revokes the instruments identified in column (1) of the Tables in Part 1 (subordinate legislation) and Part 2 (direct assimilated legislation) of the Schedule to the extent specified in column (2) of those Tables.

Those revocations include the revocation on 23rd June 2026 of the direct assimilated legislation amended by regulations 5 and 6 of these Regulations on 6th April 2025. This will end transitional provisions in that legislation that permits certain non-compliant products using relevant protected names to be marketed until stocks are exhausted.

Regulation 8 makes amendments to the Genetically Modified Organisms (Deliberate Release) Regulations 2002 (S.I. 2002/2443) consequent on the revocation by Schedule 1 to the 2023 Act of—

- (a) Council Decision of 3 October 2002 establishing pursuant to Directive 2001/18/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council the summary information format relating to the placing on the market of genetically modified organisms as or in products (2002/812/EC), and
- (b) Council Decision of 3 October 2002 establishing, pursuant to Directive 2001/18/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council, the summary notification information format for notifications concerning the deliberate release into the environment of genetically modified organisms for purposes other than for placing on the market (2002/813/EC).

A full impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no, or no significant, impact on the private, voluntary or public sector is foreseen.
