Consultation on the proposed Southern North Sea and Eastern Channel Mixed Flatfish Fisheries Management Plan (FMP)

I am writing to Southern North Sea and Eastern Channel Mixed Flatfish and its associated Environmental Report.

This consultation is an opportunity for you to help shape and influence the future of Southern North Sea and Eastern Channel Mixed Flatfish management policy in England and builds upon previous engagement with industry.
