## Consultation on the abolition of Food from Britain

1. I am writing to invite comments on the Government's plans for the legislative abolition of Food from Britain; the Defra sponsored Non-Departmental Public Body which promoted UK food exports between 1983 and 2009. Although FFB closed its operations in March 2009 and no longer functions as a public body, the legislation which established FFB is still in place.

2. The purpose of this consultation is to seek views on whether to formally dissolve FFB in law by repealing the Agricultural Marketing Act 1983, which initially established FFB, or to do nothing, allowing the legislation to remain in force for the foreseeable future. The preferred option of the UK Government is to repeal the Agricultural Marketing Act 1983.
