Dear Consultee

Public Consultation on Draft Pathway Action Plans for Invasive Non-native Species.

I am writing to invite views on Invasive Non-native Species (INNS) Pathway Action Plans (PAPs) which have been developed by working groups set up by the GB Non-native Species Secretariat and included representatives from Defra, the Scottish Government and Welsh Government, government agencies and key delivery partners.

The five draft PAP documents cover the following pathway topics: recreational boating; angling; horticulture; zoos; and pets.

They lay out best-practice approaches with key actions for Government, government agencies, businesses, NGOs, recreational clubs and individuals to help guide resources and behaviour in the right direction. Actions include raising awareness, implementing and improving biosecurity measures, and promoting best practice amongst industry and user groups. The PAPs do not change legislation or create burdens or prohibitions.

This consultation provides the opportunity to gather wider feedback on the actions within each PAP. We will consider the responses to the consultation and revise the PAP documents where appropriate, with the overall aim of making the PAPs as comprehensive as possible. This consultation is therefore a final step in developing the PAPs prior to their publication.
