DOGS ON LEADS

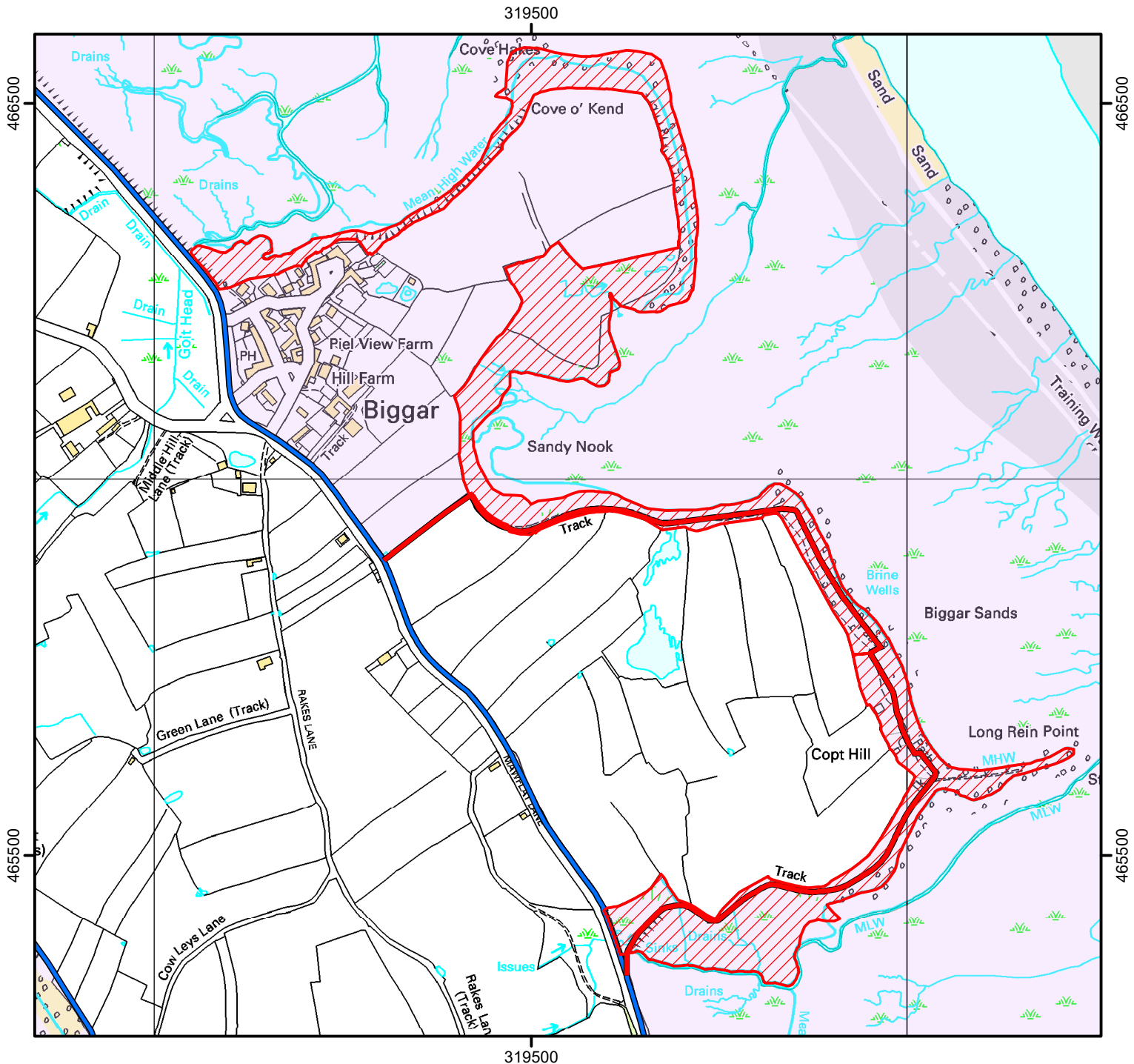



Map 2: Extent of directions on Walney Island
