1) Introduction

The Peak District National Park Authority (PDNPA) has completed its consultation on the review of the long-term direction to restrict CROW access on this land. The consultation was held between 21 February and 5 April 2024.

A response from the Peak District Local Access Forum in relation to the existing directions was received. The Local Access Forum agrees that the extent and nature of the restriction is still appropriate.

2) Outcome

The Authority has met with the Club regarding the review of this long-term direction. The Club has confirmed that the direction is required for the purposes for which it was originally applied for and that there have been no changes to the level and nature of use.

The PDNPA is satisfied that the restriction of CRoW access in accordance with the use of the land for shooting and fall of shot is necessary on land management and public safety grounds and to have regard to requirements for site certification.

It is proposed that the existing direction continues as follows:

- Extend the end date to provide a further 6 years
