1) Introduction

The Peak District National Park Authority (PDNPA) has completed its consultation on the review of the long-term direction to restrict CROW access on this land. The consultation was held between 31 October and 29 November 2024.

2) Outcome

The Authority has met with the landowner regarding the review of this long-term direction. The landowner has confirmed that the direction is required for the purposes for which it was originally applied for and that there have been no changes to the level and nature of use.

The landowner has no suitable alternative land for keeping his stock when calving or have calves at foot. A through route is available for those without dogs and the direction is conditional on this concession path to the land being available at all times.

The PDNPA is satisfied that the restriction of CRoW access is necessary on land management grounds and, subject to further review of the line of the concession path, it is proposed that the existing direction continues as follows:

- Extend the end date to provide a further 6 years
- The concession path to the land to be available at all times
