A consultation comment from the Peak District Local Access Forum was received in relation to the existing direction. The Forum is satisfied that the restriction on dogs is reasonable on the basis of safety and for access opportunities for the public as a whole afforded by the concession path.

The owner has no suitable alternative land for keeping his stock when calving or have calves at foot and the direction is required for the purposes for which it was originally applied for. A through route is available for those without dogs. The direction is conditional on this concession path to the land being available at all times.

Subject to further consultation, it is proposed that the existing direction is varied as follows:

- Extend the end date to provide a further 6 years
- The concession path to the land to be available at all times
