NO DOGS

Dogs are excluded from hatched land due to lambing and calving.

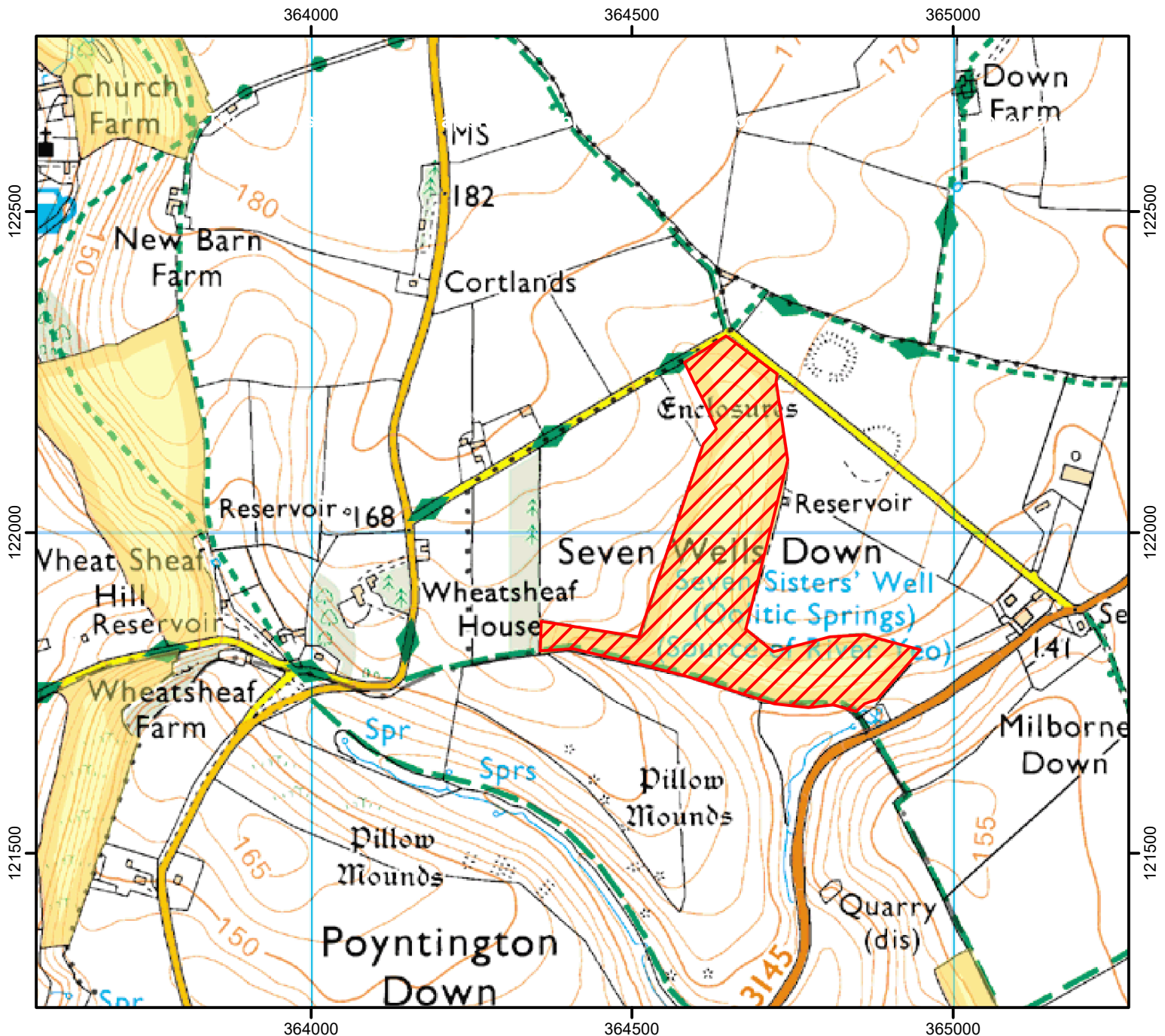
This exclusion does not apply to the bridleway where dogs must be kept under close control.

Visitors outside the restriction period are asked to keep to the bridleway and waymarked route, and if not on the bridleway dogs must be kept on a short lead in the vicinity of livestock.

However if you and your dog are chased by cattle it is safer to let your dog off the lead.

From 1st February to 31st August annually.
