Dartmoor National Park Authority has now decided how to proceed following its review of the above mentioned [long-term] direction to restrict CROW Access rights on this land. A [second] consultation has been held between 26 October 2018 and 16 November 2018 with statutory consultees and the general public. We received feedback from a number of consultees including:

Dartmoor Preservation Association, Kennel Club, Natural England, Open Spaces Society and Ramblers

In summary the feedback was as follows:

All respondents were in support of the proposed variation to the access restriction

### Outcome of the review:

Dartmoor National Park Authority's decision is to vary the extent or nature of the direction in a different way from that originally proposed

The Authority is mindful of pursuing the least restrictive approach when managing access and has concluded that the current level of restriction should be amended from a total exclusion on dogs, to a requirement to have dogs on leads at all times within the restriction zone.

#### For long term directions

Natural England's policy for long term directions is that they should not be given for a period of more than 6 years. Therefore the original direction will be varied to have an end date of December 2024.

## Summary of changes made to the existing directions:

If you are only extending the end date and not varying the extent or nature of the direction you are not making a change to the direction and do not need to complete this section.
