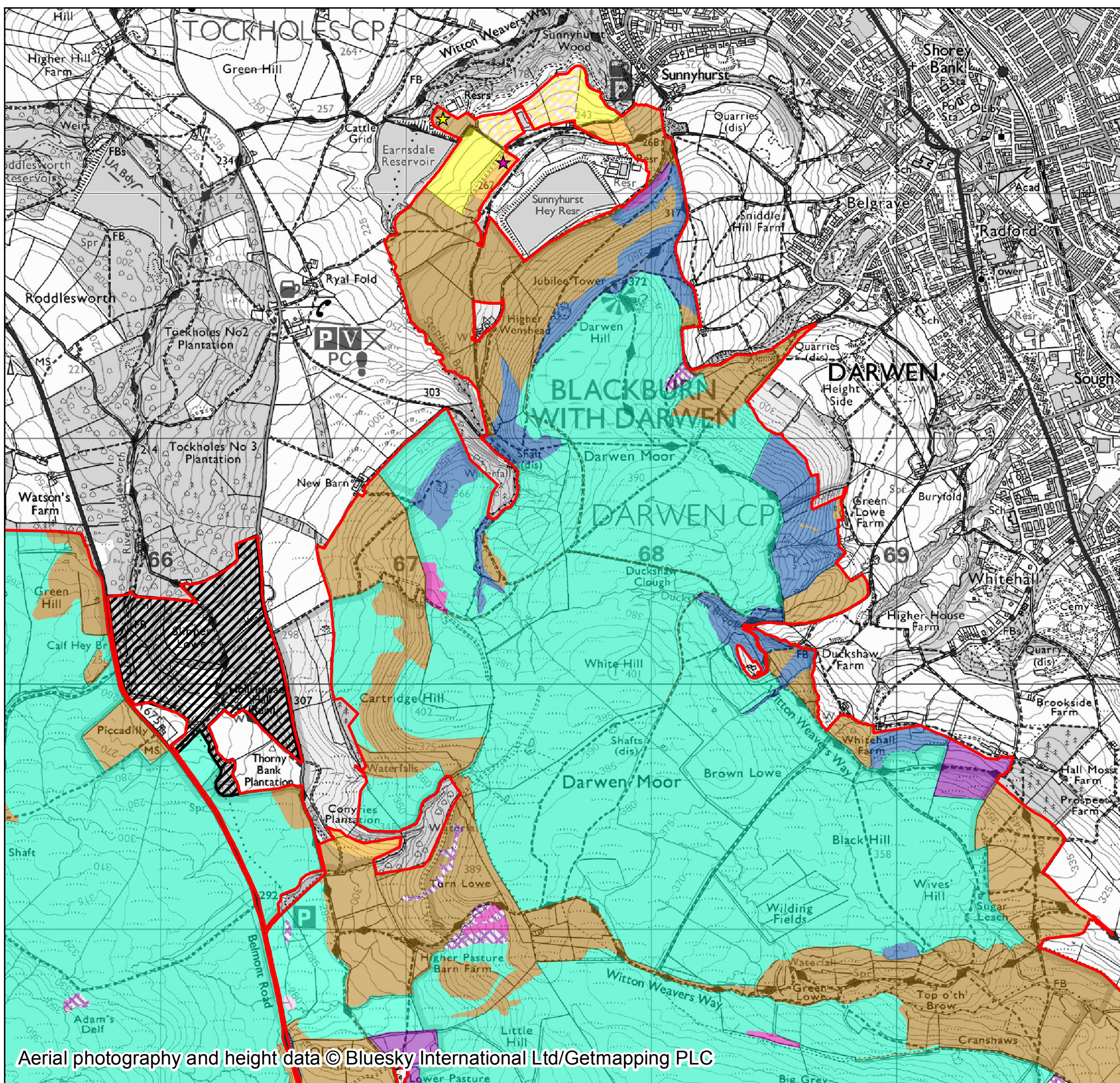

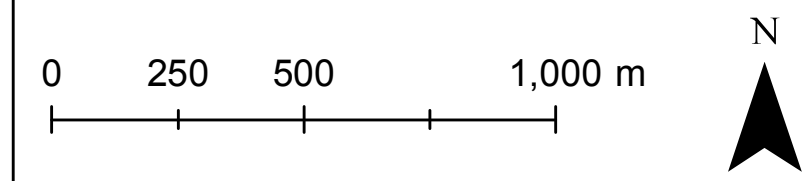
## Priority Habitats and Features Map

-  SSSI boundary
- Upland habitats**
  -  Blanket bog (M2, M3, M18, M19, M20, M21, M25)
  -  Dry heath (H8, H9, H12)
  -  Acid flushes (M6)
  -  Lime-rich flushes (M9)
  -  Upland fen/rush pasture transition or mosaic (M6, M23, M25, M26)
  -  Additional upland breeding bird habitat
- Moorland fringe grasslands**
  -  Neutral hay meadows and pastures (MG3)
  -  Neutral hay meadows and pastures (MG5)
  -  Neutral grasslands with restoration potential (MG6/MG3)
  -  Rush pastures and mire grasslands (M23, M25, M26)
- Nationally Rare lady's mantle**
  -  *Alchemilla acutiloba*
  -  *Alchemilla subcrenata*
- Woodland**
  -  Habitat supporting woodland breeding birds

**NB. All notified upland habitats and moorland fringe grasslands also provide key upland breeding bird habitat**
