**Consultation on whether England and Wales should change their Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathies (TSEs) related livestock feed controls**

I am writing to invite views on the proposed changes to the TSE- related livestock feed controls.

We are seeking views on proposals to change the current livestock feed controls to allow:

- porcine processed animal protein (PAP) to be fed to poultry
- poultry PAP to be fed to porcine animals
- insect PAP to be fed to poultry and porcine animals
- ruminant collagen and gelatine in non-ruminant feed
